Open call for demo cases program

MedPhab, Europe's first pilot line for photonics-based medical devices, is launching an Open Call for the external companies developing medical products. The objective of the Open Call is to **provide technology development services for the companies that are adopting advanced photonics technologies in the medical diagnostics solutions**. As the technology development services are pioneering in nature, we provide subsidized financial support to up to 20 business cases. For small and medium enterprises (SMEs) the support is 75% of the costs and for large enterprises the support is 50%.

The **MedPhab** consortium consists of research organizations and industrial parties with **ISO13485** certificate allowing the seamless development from early phase proof-of-concept to regulated pilot production. Depending on the phase of the development, the most suitable **MedPhab** party or parties are selected as developer.

Participation in the open call: The proposal submission has two stages: a pre-screening phase and a full proposal submission (more details in <https://medphab.eu/open-call/>).

Pre-screening phase: Continuous process starting on January 2022

Full proposal phase: Evaluation every two months starting on March 2022 until April 2023

Expected duration of participation: 3-12 months

Maximum amount of EU-financial support for each project: 250K€
